There are two categories of prohibited behaviour Category 1 and category 2

CATEGORY 1

1. Techniques which make excessive contact having regard to the scoring area attached
...and techniques which make contact with throat
2. Attacks to th arms or legs ,groin , joints or instep
3. Attacks to the face with open hand techniques
4. Dangerous or forbidden throwing techniques

CATEGORY 2

1. Feigning ,or exaggerating injury
 2. Repeated exits from the competition area (JOGAI)
 3. Self-endangerment by indulging in behaviour, which exposes the contestant to injury
... by the opponent or failing to take adequate measures for self-protection (MUBOBI)
 4. Avoiding combat as a means of preventing the opponent having the opportunity to score
 5. Clinching wrestling , pushing, or seizing, without attempting a throw or other technique
 6. Techniques which by their nature, cannot be controlled for the safety of the opponent
...and Dangerous and uncontrolled attacks
 7. Attacks with the head, knee, o elbows
 8. Talking to or goaling the opponent, failing to obey the orders of the referee .
- discourteous behaviour towards the refereeing officials, or other breaches of etiquette

Compulsory protective equipment

1. Hand mitts
2. Gum shield
3. Chest protector (female)
4. Groin guard (male)

Non compulsory protective equipment

1. Shin guards
2. Head guard
3. Foot guard (Shoe)

MATTED AREA

Full area eight metres square
Fighting area six metres square

POINT SYSTEM

Ipon (One Point)

1. Head punch (Jodan)
2. Chest punch (Chudan)
3. Back fist (Jodan)

Nihon (Two Points)

1. Punch to the back (Chudan)
2. Any kick to middle of the body (chudan)
3. Three punches to the chest (Zanbon zuki)
4. Half sweep and a punch

Zambon (Three Points)

1. Head Kick (Jodan)
2. Full sweep and then a attack
